

1. Finished edge is the actual edge of the BladeTape. Any images on the outside of this line will get cutoff.
2. Bleed edge is where all background colours should bleed out to, to ensure continuous colour to the edge of the BladeTape.
3. Ensure all images are masked or cropped within the bleed shape.
4. Remove or hide the finished edge shape when finalizing art, otherwise the black finished edge shape will print.
5. 200 - 300 dpi is recommended for placed art.
6. Call out pantone colours or the cmyk alternative.
7. Save finished art as a pdf seperated into player left, player right, goalie left, goalie right. 4 files in total.
